Adulteration of drinks in Pakistan

The authorities seized 18.800 litres of spurious drinks adulterated with hazardous chemicals, loose non-food grade colours, artificial sweeteners, unclean tap water, and other harmful ingredients.

The authorities seized several tons of bakery products already expired but relabelled with new expiry dates (total value of 1 million Euros).

Adulterated Beverages in Pakistan

The authorities uncovered a fake beverages manufacturing unit producing carbonated drinks with labels from famous brands by using hazardous chemicals, loose non-food grade colours, artificial sweeteners, unclean tap water, and other harmful ingredients.

The authorities seized 2.000 liters of carbonated drinks with counterfeit labels.

Adulterated beverages in Brazil

The authorities seized 200.000 liters of adulterated beverages (20.6 tons of concentrated juice, nectars, 64.000 liters of balsamic vinegar, 4.550 liters of sugarcane spirit, 2.700 liters of wine, brandy, cachaça and 65.000 liters of coconut water). Irregularities included:

- Addition of unauthorized cane sugar above the permitted amount;
- Dilution of drinks with excess water;
- Use of dyes and sweeteners to mask the product to consumers;
- Irregular advertising;
- Transportation of beverages in inappropriate and irregular conditions;
- Inadequate production conditions.

Expired powdered milk seized in Kenya

The authorities seized 37.775 tons of expired powdered milk (unfit for human consumption) ready to be relabelled with new expiry dates (total value of 510.000 Euros).

The authorities seized 7.900 soft drinks with counterfeit labels of famous brands.

The Egyptian authorities closed down an unlicensed factory producing tahini from harmful materials such as e.g. ceramic powder and peanut husks.

Authorities from Hong Kong seized 9 745 packages of bagged seaweed roll rice crackers from China. They were mislabelled as being from Japan (total value of 11.260 Euros).

Campaign to analyze adulteration in honey in Brazil

The Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock (Mapa) carried out a campaign to analyze adulteration in honey samples collected in retail stores. 14% of 99 samples presented adulteration by C-4 sugars, and 31.5% of 109 samples were non-compliant for levels of hydroxymethylfurfural and amylase.

In 2021, the European Commission organized the EU coordinated action called 'From the Hives' to assess the prevalence on the market of imported honey adulterated with sugars. Almost half (46%) of the 320 samples were suspicious of not complying with the provisions of the 'Honey Directive'.
